

User Content & Public Trip Reports

By submitting content to the platform, including trip reports, photos, comments, route information, and other material (“Content”), you confirm that you own the Content or have the necessary rights and permissions to post it.

Users retain ownership of their Content unless they choose to publish it publicly.

Content submitted to the platform must be reasonably related to outdoor recreation, travel, camping, canoeing, hiking, portaging, route planning, nature, or other activities relevant to Algonquin Trip Logging and its community.

By publishing Content publicly, you dedicate that public Content to the public domain to the fullest extent permitted under applicable law, including under the CC0 1.0 Universal Public Domain Dedication. Public Content may be copied, modified, distributed, reused, archived, indexed, downloaded, or republished by anyone for any purpose, including commercial purposes, without notice, attribution, or compensation. Users may delete or unpublish their public Content at any time while their account remains active and in good standing. Upon deletion or unpublishing, the platform will stop publicly displaying the Content within a commercially reasonable period.

However, users acknowledge and accept that copies, archives, cached versions, screenshots, downloads, or redistributions made by other users, search engines, third parties, or automated systems before removal may continue to exist outside the platform’s control. Complete removal or deletion of public Content from the internet cannot be guaranteed.

Users are solely responsible for the Content they post and for ensuring that it does not violate any law, infringe intellectual property or privacy rights, or disclose confidential or personal information without permission.

The platform reserves the right, but not the obligation, to remove, restrict, moderate, or disable access to any Content at any time for any reason, including Content believed to violate these Terms, community guidelines, or applicable law.

Users must not upload Content that:

- is unrelated to the intended purpose of the platform or is primarily promotional, commercial, or spam-related;
- infringes copyright, trademark, privacy, or other legal rights;
- contains unlawful, defamatory, harassing, hateful, or abusive material;
- includes personal information of another person without consent;
- impersonates another individual or organization; or
- contains malware, spam, or malicious code.
